3.26 Major Activities during the year in the sphere of extension activities and Institutional Social Responsibility

1. Conducted 1 week work shop on “New Technology on automobiles” under community college in our institution with the help of Sai Service Pvt. Ltd. Goa nearly 120 students participated in the work shop.
2. Our college and Ran baxy Co. Jointly organised one day free ortho cheque up to our teaching and Non teaching staff. Nearly 300 teaching & Non teaching staff of our campus attended this camp.
3. Nearly 120 NSS volunteers of our college participated in one day cleanliness camp organised by the Karnatak University, Dharwad on 28th September 2014.
4. Our college sports students attended 64th Karnataka University intercollegiate athlete meet during 2014-2015 & bagged men’s championship and runners up of the overall athlete meet.
5. A special lecturer on Biodiversity of western Ghats by Dr. G.R.Shivamurthy of Mysore was conducted by the Department of Botany for degree Science students and staff.
6. All the National day celebrations were observed in the college by conducting special lectures by the concerned resource persons Viz., National Voter’s day, Teachers day, Republic day, Independence day & Birth annuarsary of renowned personalities etc.
7. The fine arts students of our college participated in National Level & State level Drama competition and won 2nd place & 1st place respectively.
8. On 9th February 2015 under the joint organisation of our college youth Red Cross unit, cancer Hospital, Hubli and District Health centre, Blood donation camp organised in our college and nearly 150 students of degree course donated their blood.
9. On 14th February 2015 under youth red cross unit of our college H1, N1 awareness programme was conducted at the high schools and Kelageri villages by our students and resource persons.
10. On March 13th and 14th 2015 two days state level workshop on Food adulteration and detection of adulteration and food safety measures was conducted in our college by the Department of Chemistry. Nearly 300 students of various colleges were given hand on training by our staff and experts invited from CFTRI Mysore followed by press meet.
11. A debated “India will be a powerful Nation before 2020” and essay writing on “effect of social networking sites on Society” were conducted in our college. Nearly 20-25 students of various college participated in the events.
